### June 1, 2017: Calgary

### June 2, 2017: Calgary Sightseeing

**Calgary Tower:** Officially opened on 30 June 1968, the "Tower" has become the City of Calgary's most famous and identifiable physical landmark. Ride to the top and experience the great sightseeing elevation pass of the entire city. A must do while in Calgary! Visitors to the Observation Deck are able to virtually "step out into" space on the glass floor experience. Imagine standing 525 feet above the ground in the heart of Calgary and being able to look straight down and directly out in front of you into the heart of the city. The experience will be awe-inspiring and will challenge the emotions, but rest assured, the thrill will be worth it.

### Calgary Zoo

From the splendor of our Canadian Wilds exhibit to the heart of Destination Africa, visit over 900 animals from around the world! Trek through a rain forest with lowland gorillas, safari over the African Savannah to watch hippos swimming, hike through Eurasia with the tigers or go up to the Rocky Mountains to find the grizzly bears. Complete your world tour with a trip through time in our Prehistoric Park or soothe your senses in nearly six acres of our beautiful Botanical Gardens.

### June 3, 2017: Drumheller Tour

Departing from Calgary east into the endless golden prairies, the fertile land suddenly drops away into a strange and stark moonscape of weird striped hills and otherworldly rock formations – The Badlands. View the impressive Horseshoe Canyon and learn about the geology, history, and native plants and animals at the Interpretive Centre. Next is the town of Drumheller, the Dinosaur Capital of the World, and a visit to the Royal Tyrrell Museum of Paleontology, home of 130,000 fossils of over 300 different species and one of the best dinosaur museums in the world. Explore the fascinating exhibits, watch a raptor skeleton being assembled, meet the scientists that interpret the past, and learn what happens behind the scenes to collected fossils. Leaving Drumheller, we'll head to the Atlas Coal mine for a guided tour of this fascinating national historic site. Then a stop to view the Hoodoos, unique geological formations that resemble sandstone giants. Return to Calgary late afternoon.
