#### June 9, 2017: Lake Louise to Jasper Tour including the Ice Explorer and the Sky Walk

Today's tour to Jasper takes us through some of the most spectacular mountain landscapes in North America. Following the spine of the Canadian Rockies, view a never-ending procession of mammoth mountains, jagged snowy peaks, and over 100 glaciers. The entire day is spent in the majesty of Canada's two most famous National Parks, Banff and Jasper. Departing from Lake Louise, we travel northwards on the Icefields Parkway, one of the most scenic stretches of highway in North America. Stops will be made at Crowfoot Glacier, Bow Lake, Peyto Lake and the Weeping Wall before arriving at the Athabasca Glacier and Columbia Icefield. A stop is made at the Columbia Icefield chalet to view the Athabasca Glacier, time is allowed to ride the Ice Explorer onto the glacier. From here the parkway descends Tangle Ridge and follows the Athabasca River, which begins as melt water from the Athabasca Glacier. We then stop at the Athabasca Falls, where the boiling waters of the river plunge into a chasm gouged out of the valley floor. Departs Daily @ 8.30am. Duration 9 hours. 3 Nights of Accommodation in the Crimson Hotel Jasper – Standard Room.

#### lune 10, 2017; lasper Sightseeing

Jasper SkyTram - including Transportation. The experience of riding Canada's longest and highest aerial tramway into Jasper's National Park's alpine tundra will captivate all ages. Discover views unsurpassed in the Canadian Rockies. Gaze over six mountain ranges, glacial-fed lakes, meandering rivers and the scenic Jasper Town site. By the time you reach the upper terminal of Whistler's Mountain you will have gained over 973 metres.
